DAY 1 **TRINIDAD TOUR & MUSEUM** L

Drive north along the Sangre de Cristo Mountains to Springer to dine at the historic Brown Hotel. Then continue over Raton Pass to Trinidad, Colorado. Learn about Trinidad's wealth of history on a tour of the city and at the Trinidad Historical Museum, which includes historic homes and gardens and the Santa Fe Trail Museum.

DAY 2 **HIGHWAY OF LEGENDS** B

The Highway of Legends, from Trinidad to La Veta, is one of the most beautiful and historic drives in Colorado. See Cokedale, now a living National Historic District; fascinating geologic formations; and panoramic views of the Spanish Peaks while learning the history and geology of the area. Return to Trinidad, then continue home to Albuquerque.

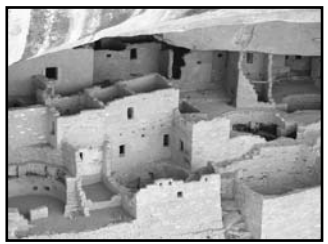

DAY 1 **MESA VERDE / CLIFF PALACE**

Drive through the colorful country of northeastern New Mexico and reach Mesa Verde National Park in Colorado. Here are some of the world's largest and best preserved cliff dwellings tucked into caves in canyon walls. Start with a tour of Cliff Palace, the grandest of them all. Climbing ladders is required. Lodge in the park at Far View Lodge.

DAY 2 **MESA VERDE**

Continue guided sightseeing of cliff dwellings and surface dwellings in Mesa Verde National Park this morning. Then return to Albuquerque.

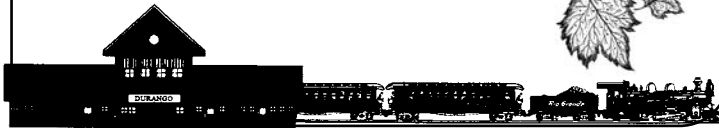

DAY 1 **ALBUQUERQUE / DURANGO**

DAY 1 **TAOS PLAZA, PUEBLO & ART** D

Drive to the Santuario de Chimayo, then up the Rio Grande Valley to Taos. There is free time on the Taos Plaza to visit galleries, museums, and shops. At the Taos Art Museum see the work of the "Taos Eight" in the Fehin Home & Studio. Tour Taos Pueblo, the most impressive of all the pueblos. Lodge in Taos.

DAY 2 **ENCHANTED CIRCLE** B

Begin the Enchanted Circle drive with the Millicent Rogers Museum's superb collection of Indian blankets, baskets, jewelry, pottery, etc. From the Rio Grande Gorge Bridge look down the deep, narrow gorge. Stop at the D. H. Lawrence Ranch where the famous author lived in the 1920s. Watch for **golden aspen color** en route to Red River. Visit the Vietnam Veterans Memorial in Angel Fire, then return to Albuquerque.
