**DAY 1 HOME / BAY CRUISE**

We fly to San Francisco and start our sightseeing at Pier 39 with a San Francisco Bay cruise that takes us under the Golden Gate Bridge, past Alcatraz Island, and along the San Francisco waterfront. Then, after an orientation drive, we settle in at the **Westin St. Francis**, San Francisco's most famous and best located hotel, where we lodge five nights.

**DAY 2 CITY TOUR / FREE TIME**

On our morning city tour we discover the many facets of San Francisco: Chinatown, Nob Hill, the Civic Center, Seal Rocks, Golden Gate Park and a view of it all from Twin Peaks. The afternoon is free to enjoy San Francisco's ambiance and attractions. How about a cable car ride to Fisherman's Wharf?

**DAY 3 MUIR WOODS / SAUSALITO**

We cross the Golden Gate Bridge into Marin County to reach Muir Woods National Monument where redwood trees reach the heavens. Sausalito provides shopping and vistas across the Bay. The rest of the afternoon is free time to savor vibrant San Francisco.

**DAY 4 GUIDE DOGS / SONOMA & NAPA VALLEYS**

Napa and Sonoma Valleys are famous not only for their high-quality wines, but also for their lovely scenery. En route to Sonoma Valley we stop at the heartwarming Guide Dogs for the Blind where guide dogs are trained. A human guide shows us the dog school and introduces us to some students. We have free time in Sonoma, a historic town that has retained much of its original charm and beauty. Then we visit a Napa Valley winery where we first learn how wines are made, then sample the fruit of the vine. We return to San Francisco for a seafood dinner at Fisherman's Wharf.

**DAY 5 Birth of Impressionism / FREE TIME**

We see the *Birth of Impressionism* exhibit at the de Young Museum which has recently reopened in a new building to showcase its world-class collections. Transportation back to the hotel is not included so everyone can stay as long as they like. The rest of the day is free time to explore San Francisco.

**The Birth of Impressionism:**

Masterpieces from the Musée d'Orsay exhibit at the De Young Museum features the early masters of Impressionism including Renoir, Monet, Degas, Manet, Morisot, and Whistler. Because Paris' Musée d'Orsay is undergoing renovation, 100 masterpieces are coming to San Francisco. *Impressionist Paris: City of Light* at the Legion of Honor transports visitors to Paris circa 1874 as represented in over 100 paintings, drawings, etc.

**DAY 6 Impressionist Paris: City of Light / FLIGHT HOME**

We view the Legion of Honor's outstanding collection of art along with the special exhibit: *Impressionist Paris: City of Light*.
