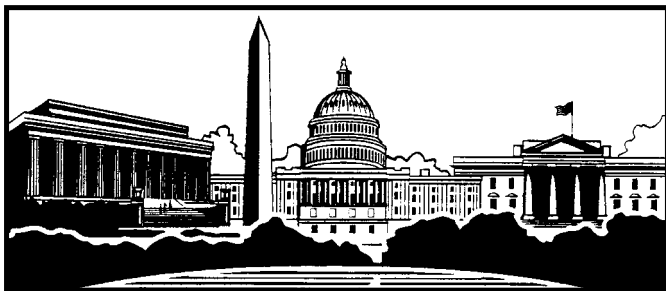

DAY 1 HOME / WASHINGTON

We fly to Washington where we lodge for six nights at the Renaissance Dupont Circle Hotel. It is located less than half a mile from the National Mall monuments, the White House, and Georgetown. The Smithsonian museums are less than a mile away.

DAY 2 CHERRY BLOSSOMS / CITY TOUR B

Our local guide shows us our nation's capital starting with the cherry blossoms and the classic Jefferson Memorial in the Tidal Basin. We also see the federal buildings, the White House, the Capitol Building, the Smithsonian museums, the foreign embassies, and Georgetown. Then we tour the gothic National Cathedral, the sixth largest in the world. During our free afternoon we visit our favorite Washington attractions.



DAY 3 MOUNT VERNON / MEMORIALS B

We drive to Mount Vernon, George Washington's impressive home on the Potomac River for 45 years. We can tour the Mansion house, a dozen outbuildings, Washington's tomb, and the Museum & Education Center. Back in Washington we see the Air Force, World War II, and FDR memorials. The Lincoln, the Vietnam War, and the Korean War memorials complete our day.

DAY 4 FREE DAY B

From our hotel's central location Washington's attractions are near at hand. The Smithsonian Museums are less than a mile away and can be reached on foot, by cab, or the Metro. Choose from the National Gallery of Art, Museum of the American Indian, Air & Space Museum, American History Museum, Holocaust Memorial Museum, Arts and Industries Museum, Corcoran Gallery of Art, Natural History Museum, Freer Gallery of Art, and many more. Scores of other attractions near the city center are just a short cab ride away.

DAY 5 WHITE HOUSE / CAPITOL BUILDING B

We tour the White House, home of our president. Then we visit the Jefferson Building of the Library of Congress, one of America's most beautiful buildings. We also tour the Capitol Building where our senators and congressmen pass laws. At Ford's Theater & the Petersen House we see where Lincoln was shot and where he died.

DAY 6 HILLWOOD / FREE TIME B

The air is fresh along the Potomac River as we again walk among the blossoming cherry trees of the Tidal Basin. Then we visit Hillwood, the former home of Marjorie Merriweather Post. It has a peerless collection of furniture and decorative art. Beautiful formal, Japanese, and rose gardens surround the house. More free time this afternoon.

DAY 7 ARLINGTON CEMETERY / HOME B

We cross the Potomac River to Arlington Cemetery. Here we visit the Women in Military Service Memorial, the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, and JFK's grave site. We return to the Washington airport for our late afternoon flight home.
