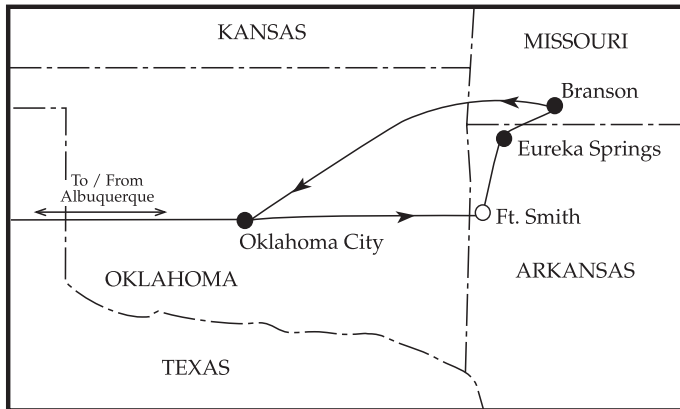


# BRANSON and the OZARKS

## DAY 1 **HOME / OKLAHOMA**

We drive east across the plains of eastern New Mexico, the Texas Panhandle, and into Oklahoma. We lodge one night in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.

## DAY 2 **FT. SMITH / PASSION PLAY** CB,L,D

We cross into Arkansas at Fort Smith and tour the National Historic Site where Judge Parker, the "Hanging Judge," held court. We drive through some of the prettiest scenery in the Ozarks en route to Eureka Springs where we lodge one night. Tonight we see *The Great Passion Play*, which depicts Christ's last week on earth, or choose, instead, the Ozark Mountain Hoe-Down for music and comedy.

## DAY 3 **EUREKA SPRINGS / BRANSON SHOW** D

Eureka Springs is a charming old spa city that clings to steep hillsides. Our orientation tour features the historic downtown, the "Christ" statue, the Passion Play site, and Thorncrown Chapel, whose award-winning glass design is inspiring. Then we have free time in Eureka Springs' historic downtown to shop and explore. Later, we cross into Missouri to reach Branson, where we lodge three nights. Dinner show tonight!

## DAY 4 **COLLEGE OF THE OZARKS / TWO SHOWS** L

This morning we tour the College of the Ozarks and its Ralph Foster Museum. Then, afternoon and evening shows round out our day with music.
