**DAY 1 HOME / NEW HAMPSHIRE**

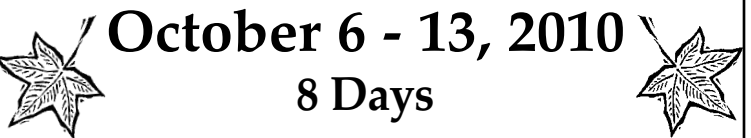
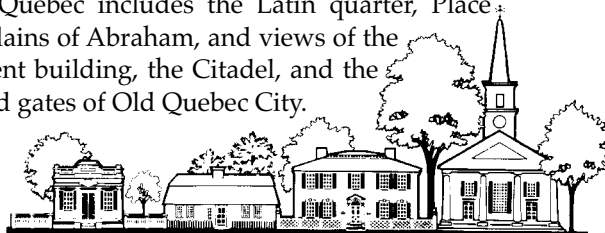
We fly to New England and lodge one night in Manchester, New Hampshire.

**DAY 2 NEW HAMPSHIRE'S WHITE MOUNTAINS L**

We drive north into New Hampshire's White Mountains, where the forests are bursting with fall foliage color. In Breton Woods we tour the Mt. Washington Hotel, one of the last of New Hampshire's grand hotels, and enjoy lunch in its historic dining room. In Vermont we see the Maple Grove Maple Museum. Then we cross the border into Canada's province of Quebec and reach Sherbrooke to lodge one night.

**DAY 3 QUEBEC & QUEBEC CITY**

We see the beautiful countryside of southern Quebec en route to Quebec City which was founded by Samuel de Champlain in 1608. The beautiful walls of old Quebec, built in the 1820s, now enclose the most charming and authentic architecture and atmosphere in North America. Our guided tour of Quebec includes the Latin quarter, Place Royal, Plains of Abraham, and views of the Parliament building, the Citadel, and the walls and gates of Old Quebec City.



**DAY 4 STE.-ANNE-DE-BEAUPRE / QUEBEC**

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We drive along the St. Lawrence River to Ste.-Anne-de-Baupre. This is the site of an impressive basilica which draws many pilgrims seeking miraculous cures. At the 274-foot-high Montmorency Falls we ride a gondola to the top of the falls, where we have lunch at the Manoir Montmorency. After our return to Quebec City, we have a free afternoon to explore the walled city from our centrally-located hotel.

**DAY 5 QUEBEC / MONTREAL**

We cross more pretty Quebec countryside to reach Montreal, a vibrant, modern city that has retained much of its heritage. Our afternoon city tour of Montreal includes Vieux (Old) Montreal, the Basilica of Notre Dame, St. Helen's Island, the Old Port, the Olympic Stadium, the view of the city from Mt. Royal, and much more. We lodge one night in downtown Montreal.

**DAY 6 VERMONT / SHELBURNE MUSEUM**

We leave Montreal and Canada behind and cross Lake Champlain into Vermont. At Shelburne Museum we see traditional buildings with art and artifacts that depict early New England life, American and French Impressionist art, 700 colorful quilts, and charming toys and dolls. Nearby, at Shelburne Farms, we tour a 1400-acre working farm on Lake Champlain that was built in the 1880s for Lila Vanderbilt Webb. We continue to Burlington, where we lodge one night.

**DAY 7 STOWE / VERMONT GRANITE**

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We drive through the resort town of Stowe to Mt. Mansfield, Vermont's highest mountain, where we ride the gondola for great views of the fall foliage. After lunch at the nearby Trapp Family Lodge, we descend from the mountains and drive to central Vermont to see Rock of Ages, the world's largest granite quarry. We lodge one night in Manchester, New Hampshire.

**DAY 8 NEW ENGLAND / HOME**

We view the New England fall foliage one last time, then fly home.
