

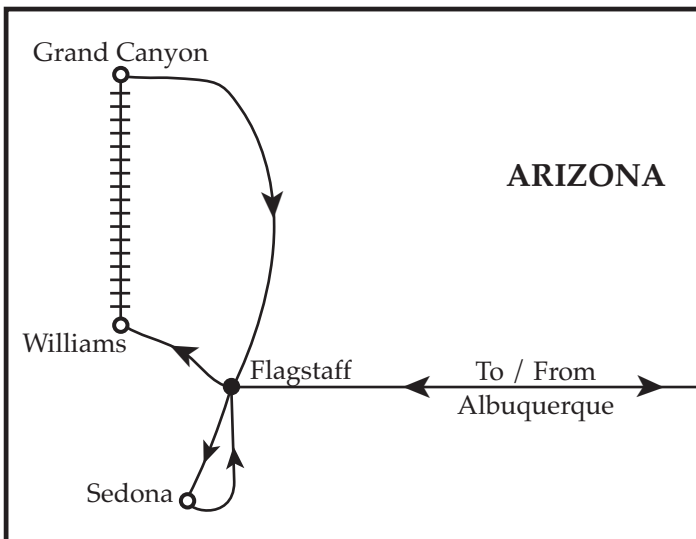
# SEDONA & GRAND CANYON TRAIN

**DAY 1 ALBUQUERQUE / FLAGSTAFF**

Canyon country, here we come! We drive west to the pine country of Flagstaff, making stops at the beautiful Painted Desert and the fascinating Petrified Forest. We lodge three nights in Flagstaff at the Little America Hotel.

**DAY 2 SEDONA / OAK CREEK**

From Flagstaff we take the scenic route to Sedona through the lovely scenery of Oak Creek Canyon. From pine forests we cross the Mogollon Rim into red rock country. At Red Rock State Park we see the Oak Creek riparian ecosystem that abounds with plants and wildlife. The Sedona Heritage Museum, located on the site of an old apple orchard, tells the story of the pioneers that settled Sedona. Then we ride the Sedona Trolley for a tour of the area featuring the Chapel of the Holy Cross. We also enjoy the ambiance of Tlaquepaque Arts and Crafts Village before returning to our hotel. After dark we visit the Lowell Observatory. If skies are clear, we look through the telescope that discovered the "planet" Pluto.

**DAY 3 GRAND CANYON BY TRAIN**

From Williams we ride to the Grand Canyon aboard the Grand Canyon Railway's restored coach cars behind a turn-of-the-century steam locomotive. What fun! From the Grand Canyon Train Station it's only a short walk to the canyon rim, where this world wonder works its magic anew. After free time at the rim we attend the IMAX Theater presentation of "Grand Canyon - The Hidden Secrets." We ride our motorcoach along the East Rim Drive to additional vistas including Desert View with the stone Watchtower, built in 1932. We then return to Flagstaff to enjoy our last night at Little America.

**DAY 4 FLAGSTAFF / ALBUQUERQUE**

After seeing the fascinating exhibits of the Museum of Northern Arizona, we say goodbye to the pine trees of the high country and enjoy our scenic ride back to Albuquerque.
