

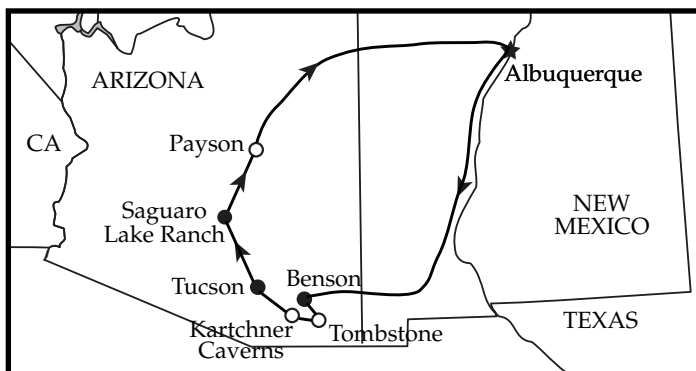

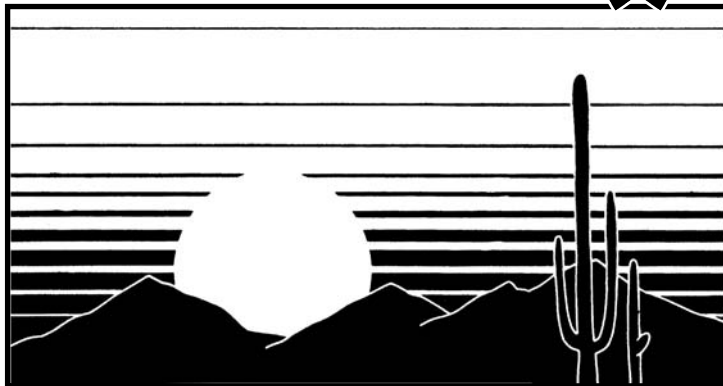
DAY 1 ALBUQUERQUE / BENSON L
 We drive south from Albuquerque along the Rio Grande stopping at the El Camino Real Heritage Center. We cross the border into Arizona, stop at Stout's Apple Cider Mill, and reach Benson where we lodge one night.

DAY 2 TOMBSTONE / KARTCHNER CAVERNS CB
 In nearby Tombstone we visit Boot Hill and the OK Corral. Then we have free time to soak in the old west atmosphere and to enjoy other attractions and the wonderfully preserved buildings of "The Town Too Tough To Die." Then we go underground at Kartchner Caverns to see the newest major cave in the USA. It is a stunning limestone cave with many world-class features, including "bird nests," "soda straws," and massive columns, all immaculately preserved and beautifully presented. We lodge two nights in Tucson.

DAY 3 TUCSON ATTRACTIONS CB,D
 The Pima Air & Space Museum is the world's largest non-government funded aerospace museum. Its collection of 250 aircraft occupies over 80 acres. The scope and quality of the collection is so fantastic that even those with no special interest are impressed. First we tour the outside exhibits with a guide on our bus, then we walk through the hangers to view the famous planes up close. At the San Xavier del Bac Mission, the "White Dove of the Desert," we see Arizona's most beautiful and most photographed mission. Then we visit the Arizona-Sonora Desert Museum which showcases the animals and vegetation from the region. It is rated as one of America's finest zoos. At Saguaro National Monument West, we see beautiful cactus landscapes and learn about these colossal cacti, the "sentinels of the desert." Dinner fun tonight!

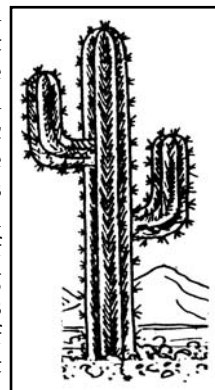

DAY 4 SAGUARO LAKE RANCH CB,L,D

At Ted De Grazia's Gallery in the Sun we see his familiar style in paintings, bronzes, and ceramics. Then we leave Tucson and head north to reach the Saguaro Lake Ranch for lunch. It is one of the most scenic guest ranches in the Southwest, a hidden treasure located on the banks of the Salt River. From our rustic ranchettes we have a panoramic view of the mountains and wilderness made famous by the writings of Zane Grey. This afternoon we board the Desert Belle for a relaxing, narrated sightseeing cruise of Saguaro Lake. We navigate past towering canyon walls and dramatic desert vistas as we watch for wildlife including birds of prey. Tonight we enjoy a cookout dinner at the ranch.

We drive across the desert, the Apache Indian Reservation, the White Mountains, and the Mogollon Rim to reach New Mexico and home.
