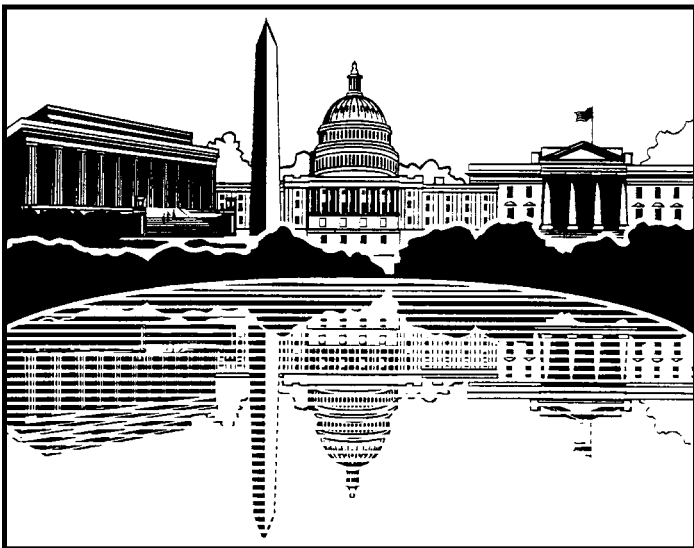

DAY 1 HOME / WASHINGTON

We fly to Washington where we lodge for six nights. Our hotel is located just one block from the heart of the Smithsonian Mall near the Air & Space Museum and the beautiful, new American Indian Museum.

DAY 2 CITY TOUR / FREE TIME

Our local guide shows us our nation's capital: the federal buildings, the White House, the Capitol Building, the Smithsonian museums, the foreign embassies, and Georgetown. We also tour the gothic National Cathedral, the sixth largest in the world. At Ford's Theater & the Petersen House we see where Lincoln was shot and where he died. The afternoon is free time for us to visit our favorite Washington attractions.



DAY 3 WHITE HOUSE / CAPITAL / MEMORIALS

We tour the White House, home of our president. Then we tour the Capitol Building where our senators and congressmen pass laws. We also visit the Jefferson Building of the Library of Congress, one of America's most beautiful buildings. We continue with more guided sightseeing including stops at the WW II Memorial and Kennedy Center.

DAY 4 HILLWOOD / FREE TIME

We visit Hillwood, the former home of Marjorie Merriweather Post. It has a peerless collection of furniture and decorative art. Beautiful formal, Japanese, and rose gardens surround the house. More free time this afternoon.

DAY 5 MOUNT VERNON / MEMORIALS

We visit the classic Jefferson Memorial, then drive to Mount Vernon, George Washington's impressive home on the Potomac River for 45 years. Back in Washington we see the new Air Force and FDR memorials. The Lincoln, the Vietnam War, and the Korean War memorials complete our day.

DAY 6 FREE DAY

From our hotel's central location by the Smithsonian Mall the country's finest museums are near at hand.
