## Fall Foliage

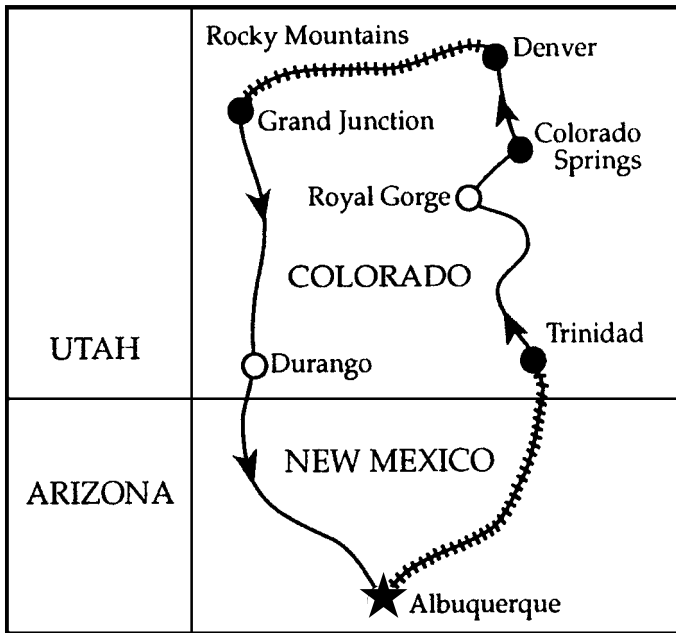
### AMTRAK, Colorado Springs, Denver, Royal Gorge

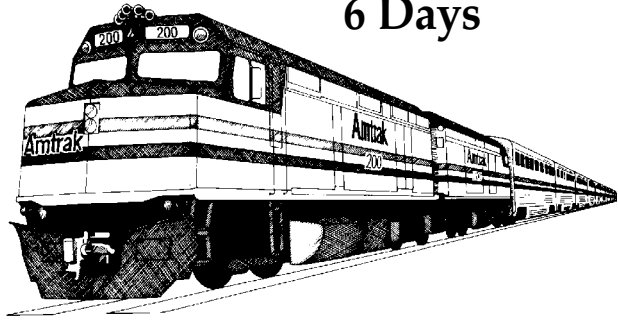
#### DAY 1 **AMTRAK TO TRINIDAD**

We board the Amtrak "Southwest Chief" in the early afternoon. From our spacious seats we watch the mountains and plains pass by on our way to the Colorado border. In Trinidad, Colorado, we disembark the train and transfer to our hotel for one night's lodging.

#### DAY 2 **ROYAL GORGE / OLYMPIC COMPLEX** CB

We drive to the famous Royal Gorge of the Arkansas River. From the highest suspension bridge in the world, we look 1,053 feet down the narrow gorge to the water. An incline railway takes us into the gorge, right down to the river. In Colorado Springs we tour the U.S. Olympic Complex, where more than 15,000 athletes train every year. #### DAY 3 **COLORADO SPRINGS**

Our tour of Colorado Springs includes the Air Force Academy with its magnificent chapel, the striking red sandstone formations at the Garden of the Gods, and the historic districts of Old Colorado City, and Manitou Springs. After we lunch at the historic Broadmoor Hotel, we visit the Pioneer Museum to learn the history of Colorado Springs and the Pike's Peak region. Then we continue to Denver, where we lodge two nights.

#### DAY 4 **DENVER**

Our tour of Denver gives us a feel for the "Mile-High City." During a free afternoon we can visit outstanding museums and shop at the 16th Street Mall, all within walking distance of our centrally-located hotel. Fun dinner at the White Fence Farm tonight!

#### DAY 5 **ROCKY MOUNTAIN RAIL RIDE**

We board Amtrak's "California Zephyr" for a scenic ride from Denver to Grand Junction. Our route crosses under the Continental Divide, through the Moffat Tunnel, then slowly descends out of the high Rockies by following the Colorado River. This all-day train ride passes some of America's most beautiful scenery.

#### DAY 6 **WESTERN COLORADO / HOME**

We board our motorcoach for a ride through western Colorado. The "Million-Dollar Highway" from Ouray to Silverton is really spectacular. After a lunch stop in Durango we drive home through colorful northwestern New Mexico.
