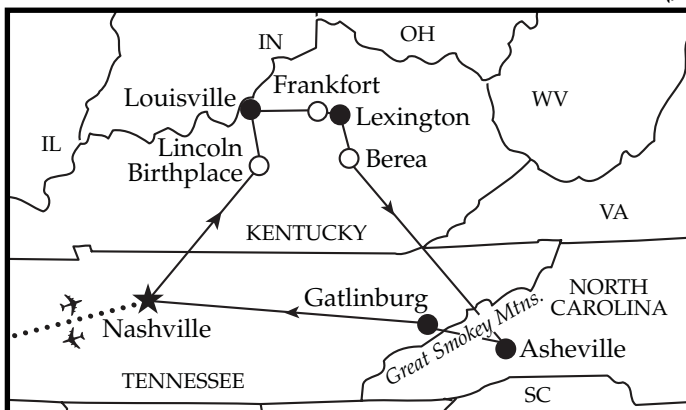

DAY 1 HOME / NASHVILLE

We fly to Nashville and visit the Hermitage, Andrew Jackson's home. We lodge two nights in Nashville.

DAY 2 NASHVILLE / GRAND OLE OPRY B,L

With our local guide we see Nashville's Music Row, the Ryman Auditorium, downtown, and much more. Lunch is served at the incredible Opryland Hotel. Then we visit the Country Music Hall of Fame. Tonight we see and hear live country music at the legendary Grand Ole Opry.

DAY 3 ABE'S BIRTHPLACE / CHURCHILL DOWNS B

We drive north into Kentucky and see where Abraham Lincoln was born, now memorialized with a log cabin in a granite memorial. In Louisville we visit Churchill Downs and the Kentucky Derby Museum where we see the famous track, a multi-media show, and exhibits. We lodge in Louisville one night.

DAY 4 LOUISVILLE / FRANKFORT / DISTILLERY

At the home of Louisville Sluggers we see baseball bats being made on a factory tour. Then we drive to Frankfort where a local guide shows us the city and the State Capitol Building. We visit the Buffalo Trace Distillery, the oldest distilling site in the United States, to find out how whiskey is made. At Old Friends we see some of the 70 thoroughbreds that live here in dignified retirement. We reach Lexington where we lodge two nights.

DAY 5 LEXINGTON / HORSES B

Splendid horse farms with lush pastures, lovely fences, and grazing horses give the Lexington bluegrass area a special feeling. After watching the morning workouts from trackside at Keeneland Race Course we drive past many horse farms on back roads. After a tour of the Mary Todd Lincoln House we go to the Kentucky Horse Park to see the International Museum of the Horse and the Parade of Breeds Show.

DAY 6 LEXINGTON / ASHEVILLE CB,L

We tour Ashland, Henry Clay's estate, then, enjoy lunch at Berea College's historic Boone Tavern. We cross the Appalachian Mountains into North Carolina to Asheville where we lodge one night.

DAY 7 BILTMORE MANSION / SMOKY MTNS. CB,L

The Biltmore Mansion, built with over 250 rooms by the Vanderbilts, is one of America's most impressive homes. We tour the mansion, enjoy the gardens, and savor lunch on the estate. Fall colors brighten the hills and hollows of the Smoky Mountains as we cross the Newfound Gap (5,000 ft) into Tennessee. We lodge one night in Gatlinburg, nestled in the Smokies.

DAY 8 GATLINBURG / HOME CB

We cross Tennessee to reach Nashville where we catch our homeward flight.
