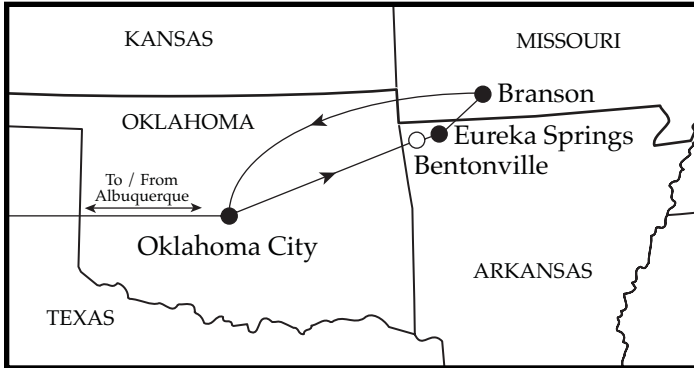


# BRANSON and the OZARKS

**DAY 1 HOME / OKLAHOMA** L

We drive east across the plains of eastern New Mexico, the Texas Panhandle, and into Oklahoma. We lodge one night in Oklahoma City.

**DAY 2 CRYSTAL BRIDGES / PASSION PLAY** B,L,D

We cross into Arkansas to reach Bentonville, home of the Walton family and Walmart. Here, Alice Walton has created the Crystal Bridges Museum of American Art which, at its opening in November 2011, instantly ranked as one of America's top art museums. After viewing the beautiful museum and its art, we continue to Eureka Springs where we lodge one night. Choose between *The Great Passion Play* or the *Ozark Mountain Hoedown*.

**DAY 3 EUREKA SPRINGS / BRANSON SHOW** B,D

Eureka Springs is a charming old spa city that clings to steep hillsides. Our orientation tour features the historic downtown, the "Christ" statue, the Passion Play site, and Thorncrown Chapel, whose award-winning glass design is inspiring. Then we have free time in Eureka Springs' historic downtown to shop and explore. Later, we cross into Missouri to reach Branson, where we lodge three nights downtown at the Hilton Convention Center on Main Street. Dinner show tonight on the Showboat Branson Belle!

**DAY 4 COLLEGE OF THE OZARKS / 2 SHOWS** L

This morning we tour the College of the Ozarks with a student guide, see its Ralph Foster Museum, and enjoy fine dining in the student-run Keeter Center. Then afternoon and evening shows round out our day with comedy and music.

**DAY 5 THREE MORE BRANSON SHOWS** D

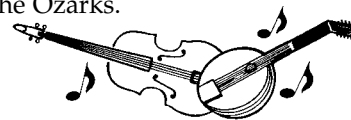
Morning, afternoon, and evening shows keep our feet a tappin'. Music and comedy fill our day, taking full advantage of our last day in Branson.
