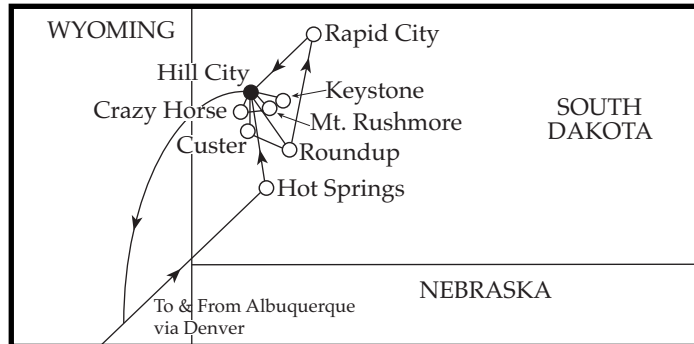

DAY 5 BUFFALO ROUNDUP

We rise early and drive to Custer State Park where we experience a scene out of the Old West. From our safe viewing area we feel the excitement of watching 1,500 head of American Bison come charging over the hills as they are herded toward the corrals. After seeing the buffalo sorted, tested, and branded we return to our hotel for rest time (or shopping time!) before returning to Mt. Rushmore tonight for the night-lighting ceremony.

DAY 1 HOME / DENVER

We drive north past the Sangre de Cristo Mountains and over Raton Pass into Colorado. We enjoy the scenery as we ride along the convergence of the Great Plains and the Rocky Mountains. We lodge one night in Denver.

DAY 2 WYOMING / MAMMOTH SITE

We are in cowboy country now as we drive through southeastern Wyoming to the Black Hills of South Dakota. In Hot Springs we visit the Mammoth Site, the world's largest mammoth research facility, and view Ice Age fossils exhibited where they were found. We lodge three nights in the heart of the Black Hills in Hill City.

DAY 3 ROUNDUP ARTS FESTIVAL & MORE

In Custer we stop at the National Museum of Woodcarving where we see incredible works by nationally renowned woodcarvers. Then we drive into Custer State Park, site of the Buffalo Roundup to enjoy the Roundup Arts Festival. Lunch is at the park's State Game Lodge, built in 1920. In the afternoon we visit Bear Country U.S.A. and Reptile Gardens. At the Fort Hay Chuckwagon Supper and Cowboy Show we enjoy a Western-style barbecue supper and a western music variety show.

DAY 4 MT. RUSHMORE / CRAZY HORSE MT.

Today we see the Black Hills' two monumental attractions, Mount Rushmore's four famous presidents and the on-going sculpting of Crazy Horse Mountain by the Ziolkowski family. At the Borglum Historical Center we learn about the making of Mt. Rushmore.



DAY 6 WYOMING / FORT LARAMIE

We leave the Black Hills behind and drive south through Wyoming to Fort Laramie National Historic Site where we tour the complex that protected Oregon Trail pioneers from the Sioux Indians. We continue to Denver where we lodge one night.

DAY 7 COLORADO / HOME

We continue our drive south through beautiful Colorado and New Mexico with great memories of the Buffalo Roundup and the "wild and wooly" Black Hills of South Dakota.
