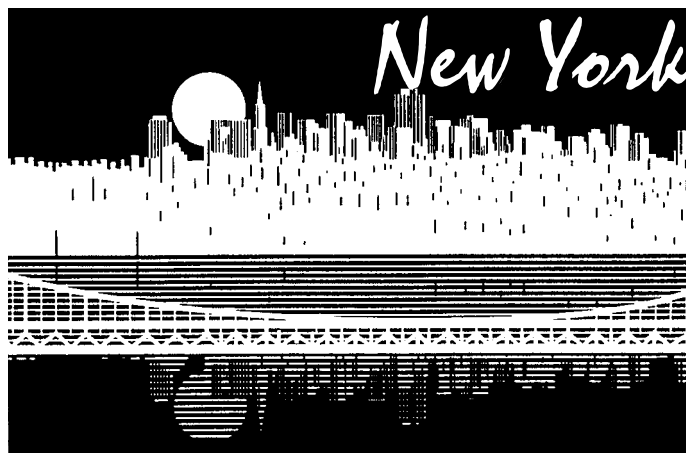
The Millennium Broadway is one of the top hotels near Times Square. It is in the heart of the Broadway Theater District.

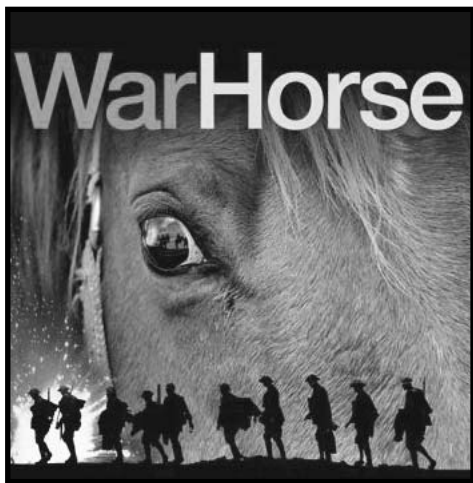
DAY 2 NEW YORK CITY TOUR

A local guide joins us for a half-day tour of Midtown and lower Manhattan. There is so much to see: Times Square, Herald Square, Macy's, the Garment District, Soho, Washington Square, Greenwich Village, Chinatown, City Hall, the Brooklyn Bridge, and much more. Our guide leads a walking tour through the new 9/11 Memorial with its cascading fountains in the footprints of the twin towers, and past Wall Street, the Stock Exchange, Federal Hall, the Federal Reserve Building, and Trinity Church. We then tour the United Nations Headquarters building and learn about its history, see gifts from around the world, and enter the impressive General Assembly Hall.

DAY 3 FREE DAY / EVITA

New York has unlimited possibilities for visitors. Shopping? From our central location at Times Square many of New York's famous stores are close at hand or easy to reach. Museums? New York has dozens of museums – something for everyone. Walking the streets is the best way to get a feel for "the city." Life here is out in the open. DAY 4 STATUE OF LIBERTY / ELLIS ISLAND

Today we drive to the lower tip of Manhattan to catch a ferry to the Statue of Liberty on Liberty Island. This international symbol of freedom is also the tallest statue in the world. Another ferry takes us to nearby Ellis Island, the point of entry for millions of immigrants from 1892 to 1924. The museum chronicles its history and the immigrants themselves. We ferry back to Manhattan and reach our hotel late in the afternoon. New York is at your service tonight with a splendid array of evening entertainment options.

DAY 5 FREE DAY / WAR HORSE

Having a free day in Manhattan is like being a kid in a candy store. There is so much to do and to explore. Tonight we see the compelling stage production of *War Horse*.

DAY 6 NEW YORK CITY TOUR

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With our guide on board we drive to Upper Manhattan. We see Lincoln Center, the Cathedral of St. John the Divine, Columbia University, Riverside Church, and visit Grant's Tomb. In Harlem we tour the legendary Apollo Theater and lunch with the locals. We return to midtown via Central Park and Fifth Avenue. Watch for the museums, elegant shops, and mansions. Our guide then leads us on a tour of St. Patrick's Cathedral and an orientation of Rockefeller Center. We ride up to the "Top of the Rock," the Observation Deck on the 70th floor of 30 Rockefeller Center, for unparalleled views.

DAY 7 RADIO CITY MUSIC HALL / HOME

On our Stage Door Tour of the Radio City Music Hall we explore the beautiful art-deco interiors, learn the secrets of the Great Stage, and meet a Rockette! Then we look up at Manhattan's skyscrapers for the last time (for this trip). We fly home filled with the energy and excitement of "the world's greatest city."
