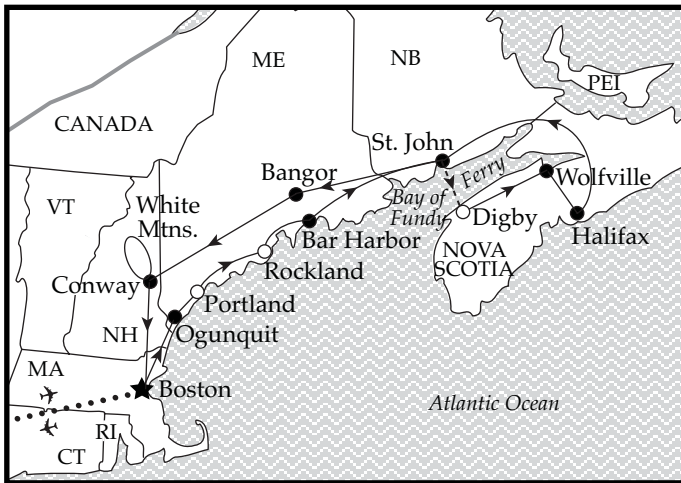

DAY 1 HOME / MAINE

We fly to Boston and then drive through New Hampshire to reach Ogunquit, Maine where we lodge one night near the beach.

DAY 2 PORTLAND / ROCKLAND / BAR HARBOR CB

Just up the coast is Portland, Maine's largest city and port. Our guided tour of the city features historic homes of the nineteenth century, the bustling waterfront, Exchange Street and the modern downtown. We take the scenic route to Rockland, "Lobster Capital of the World," where we visit the Farnsworth Art Museum, famous for its collection of the Wyeth family and other great American artists. We continue "down East" along the Maine coast to Bar Harbor where we lodge two nights.

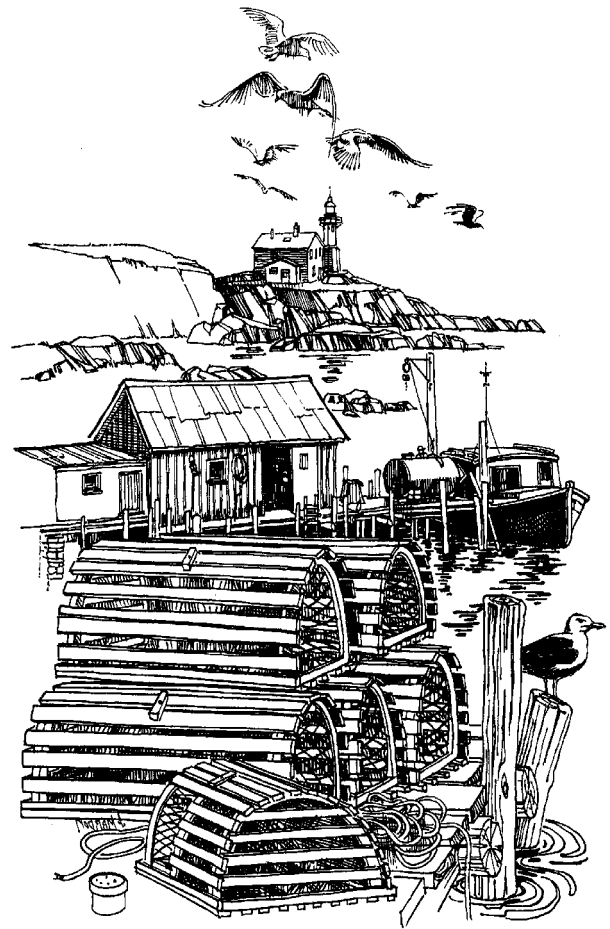
11 Days

DAY 3 ACADIA PARK / BAR HARBOR CB,D

The beauties of sea, mountain, lake, and forest are ours as we tour Acadia National Park this morning. Our afternoon is free to enjoy the atmosphere and shopping in charming Bar Harbor. Lobster bake tonight!

DAY 4 FERRY / EVANGELINE TRAIL CB

We drive across the Canadian border and continue to St. John where we board a ferry for our three-hour sailing across the Bay of Fundy. After the ferry arrives in Digby, Nova Scotia, we follow the scenic Evangeline Trail through what was once French Acadia. We lodge one night in Wolfville.



DAY 5 HALIFAX TOUR / CITY TOUR B

We visit the original French Acadian settlement of Grand Pre. Here we learn about the Acadian way of life and the Acadians' expulsion from Nova Scotia. Then we drive to Halifax where we get acquainted with the historic waterfront area. Our afternoon sightseeing tour of Halifax includes Government House, Province House, St. Paul's Church, and the harbor area. The view of Halifax is stunning from the heights of the Citadel. We also stroll through the lovely Victorian Public Gardens. We lodge two nights in Halifax.

DAY 6 PEGGY'S COVE / FREE TIME

With our local guide we skirt the Atlantic coastline of St. Margaret's Bay to Peggy's Cove, a rustic fishing village built around a snug harbor. With glacier-polished granite rocks, a quaint harbor, and a picturesque lighthouse on Rocky Point, Peggy's Cove is the delight of artists and photographers. Back in Halifax we enjoy a free afternoon. The historic waterfront area near our hotel has so many great attractions and shopping options.

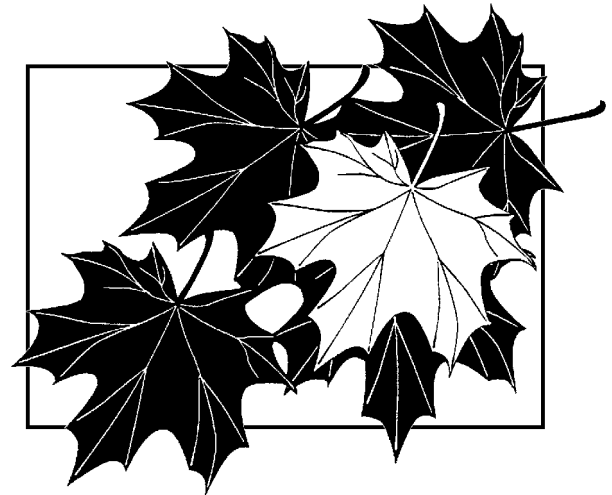


DAY 7 HALIFAX / ST. JOHN

The Glooscap Trail takes us from Nova Scotia to New Brunswick around the Bay of Fundy which has the world's highest tides. We lodge one night in the heart of the St. John Historic District, then have time to explore the area.

DAY 8 ST. JOHN / ST. ANDREWS / BANGOR D

With our local guide we tour St. John's restored downtown with many nineteenth-century buildings and see the Reversing Falls, where at high tide the St. John River runs upstream! The charming resort town of St. Andrews was partially built by Loyalists fleeing the American Revolution. After a tour and free time in St. Andrews we cross back into the USA and drive to Bangor where we lodge one night.



DAY 9 BANGOR / NEW HAMPSHIRE B,D

It's a super fall foliage day as we cross Maine past forests, fields, and farms. In New Hampshire we drive past the Presidential Mountain Range and through North Conway to reach the Purity Spring Resort where we lodge two nights. The resort has been run by the Hoyt family for generations and serves delicious meals family style.

DAY 10 WHITE MOUNTAINS B,D

A full day of sightseeing through New Hampshire's White Mountains begins with the Kancamagus Highway's legendary and unspoiled scenery. Cameras click away to capture the beauty of the fall foliage, a covered bridge, and gorgeous mountain views. We stop for a photo at the beautiful and historic Mount Washington Hotel in Bretton Woods, then pass through North Conway on our way back to Purity Spring Resort. There is time to enjoy the setting and fall foliage scenery in the late afternoon light.

DAY 11 NEW HAMPSHIRE / HOME B

We leave the mountains of New England and return to Boston where we board our jet for home, sweet home.
