TRINITY SITE & WHITE SANDS

April 6 - 7, 2012

DAY 1 **SPACE MUSEUM / WHITE SANDS**

Drive to Alamogordo and visit the New Mexico Museum of Space History where the thrill of space travel comes alive with fascinating exhibits and actual rockets. Drive to White Sands National Monument this afternoon where only white can be seen as the other worldly gypsum dunes surround us. Lodge one night in Alamogordo.

DAY 2 **TRINITY SITE / BOSQUE DEL APACHE** CB,L

Join the caravan from Alamogordo to the Trinity Site on the White Sands Missile Range. See Ground Zero, where the first atomic bomb was exploded, and the McDonald Ranch House, where the plutonium core was assembled. Continue to Bosque del Apache, where a guide points out the different bird species and other wildlife as we drive through the wildlife sanctuary. Return to Albuquerque.

CANYON de CHELLY

May 18 - 19, 2012

DAY 1 **NAVAJO NATION / CANYON de CHELLY**

Drive to Window Rock, Arizona, to see Navajo Nation Museum and tour the Navajo capital. Drive to Chinle and Canyon de Chelly. See the Visitors Center. With a guide, drive along the canyon rim which features the White House and Spider Rock Overlooks. The rust-colored walls drop steeply to the canyon floor. Lodge in Chinle.

DAY 2 **CANYON TOUR / TRADING POST / HOME**

Board special vehicles with a Navajo driver/guide for a morning tour of Canyon de Chelly's streambed. Vertical sandstone walls shelter Anasazi cliff-dweller ruins and loom over the cornfields, cottonwoods, and hogans (Navajo dwellings) on the canyon floor. The scenery is fantastic. Then, in Ganado, visit Hubbell's Trading Post, which hasn't changed in one hundred years! Today's Art Auction features Navajo arts, crafts & food vendors. Afternoon drive home.

DAY 1 **THE LODGE / SOLAR OBSERVATORY** D

The Lodge at Cloudcroft is a charming and historic resort built in 1899. It is situated 9,000 feet high in the Sacramento mountains near Alamogordo. After reaching The Lodge this afternoon, choose to play a round of golf (discounted green fee) on The Lodge's refurbished Scottish-style nine-hole course, tour the solar telescopes of the National Solar Observatory in nearby Sunspot, or just relax at The Lodge, watching for the elusive ghost, Rebecca. DAY 2 **CLOUDCROFT / SACRAMENTO MOUNTAINS** CB

Tour Cloudcroft's Sacramento Mountains Historical Museum and Pioneer Village. Then drive on scenic roads through the Sacramento Mountains to Ruidoso, enjoy free time at the spectacular Inn of the Mountain Gods, and continue home to Albuquerque.

"TEXAS" PAGEANT

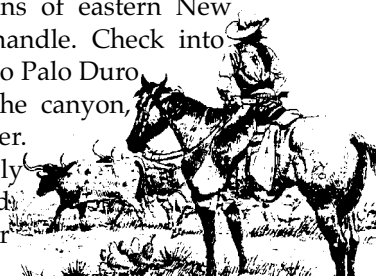
