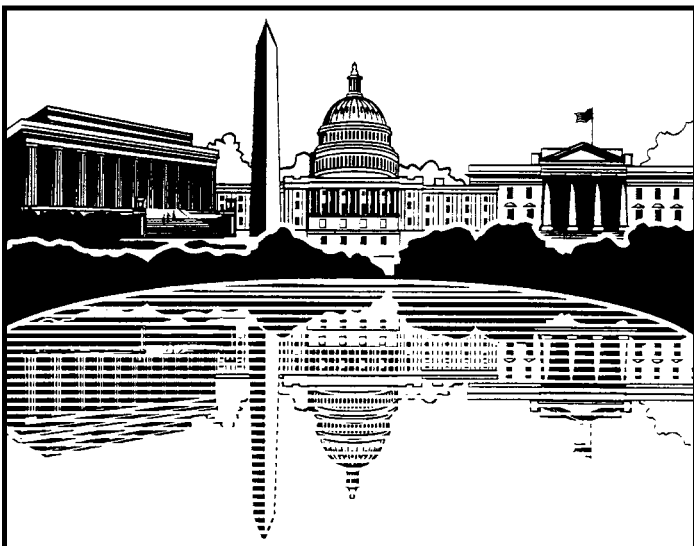

DAY 1 HOME / WASHINGTON

We fly to Washington where we lodge for six nights. Our hotel is located just one block from the heart of the Smithsonian Mall near the Air & Space Museum and the beautiful American Indian Museum.

DAY 2 CITY TOUR / FREE TIME

Our local guide shows us our nation's capital: the federal buildings, the White House, the Capitol Building, the Smithsonian museums, the foreign embassies, and Georgetown. We also tour the gothic National Cathedral, the sixth largest in the world. The afternoon is free time for us to visit our favorite Smithsonian museums and Washington attractions.



DAY 3 WW II MEMORIAL / HILLWOOD

We visit the impressive and moving World War II Memorial, then tour Hillwood, the former home of Marjorie Merriweather Post. It has a peerless collection of furniture and decorative art. Beautiful formal, Japanese, and rose gardens surround the house. More free time this afternoon.

DAY 4 MOUNT VERNON / MEMORIALS

We drive to Mount Vernon, George Washington's impressive home on the Potomac River for 45 years. We tour his home, enjoy his gardens, see his tomb, and learn about him in the museum. Back in Washington we see the new Air Force and FDR memorials. The Lincoln, the Vietnam War, and the Korean War memorials complete our day.

DAY 5 FREE DAY

From our hotel's central location by the Smithsonian Mall the country's finest museums are near at hand. Choose from the National Gallery of Art, Museum of the American Indian, Air & Space Museum, American History Museum, Library of Congress, Holocaust Memorial Museum, Arts and Industries Museum, Corcoran Gallery of Art, Natural History Museum, Freer Gallery of Art, and many more. Scores of other attractions near the city center are just a short cab ride away.

DAY 6 CAPITOL BUILDING / FORD'S THEATER

We learn about the White House and the presidency through exhibits and film at the White House Visitor Center. Then we tour the Capitol Building and enjoy its impressive visitor center. We also visit the Jefferson Building of the Library of Congress, one of America's most beautiful buildings. At Ford's Theater & the Petersen House we see where Lincoln was shot and where he died.

DAY 7 ARLINGTON CEMETERY / HOME

We cross the Potomac River to Arlington Cemetery. Here we visit the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and JFK's grave site. Then we transfer to the airport for our afternoon flight home.
