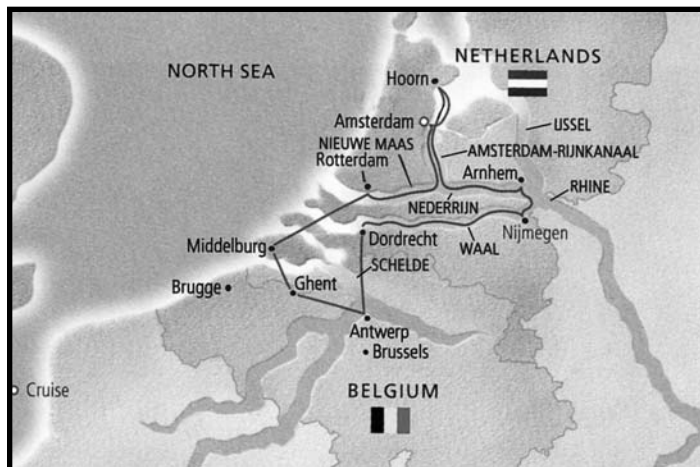

DAY 1 DEPART U.S.A.

DAY 2 AMSTERDAM / BOARD SHIP D

We transfer from the Amsterdam airport to the *Viking Europe*. We have free time to explore Amsterdam on our own or join the "welcome walk" to get oriented.

DAY 3 AMSTERDAM B,L,D

We embark on a canal tour by glass-topped boat to see architecture from the city's Golden Age. After lunch on board we enjoy free time to explore the city's charming neighborhoods. Arrangements can be made by the Program Director (at additional cost) to visit the Van Gogh Museum, the Rijksmuseum, or the Anne Frank House.

DAY 4 HOORN B,L,D

We sail across the IJsselmeer to the ancient shipping village of Hoorn where we enjoy a guided walk through Hoorn's cobbled streets. We see age-old cheese warehouses on the town's main square which dates back to Holland's Golden Age. After lunch on board we have a free afternoon to explore Hoorn, visit a bakery, and shop for souvenirs. We depart Hoorn during dinner and cruise through the night.

DAY 5 ARNHEM / NIJMEGEN B,L,D

After our early arrival in Arnhem we take a journey to 17th-century Paleis Het Loo, the Dutch royal family's summer residence for over 300 years. A guided tour of the Palace includes the sumptuously furnished rooms and the beautifully landscaped gardens. After lunch either enjoy free time in Arnhem or take the optional (additional cost) tour to the battlefield that also visits the Airborne Museum. Then we cruise to Nijmegen, one of Holland's oldest cities where we have a free evening.

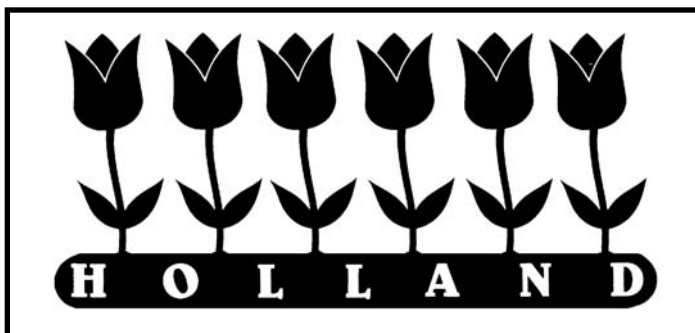

DAY 6 KINDERDIJK / ANTWERP B,L,D

We arrive in Kinderdijk where we see the UNESCO World Heritage Site of 19 windmills from the 18th century, windmills as far as the eye can see. We tour one of the working windmills to see its pumping mechanism and living quarters. In the afternoon we sail to Antwerp where we have time to explore after dinner.



DAY 7 ANTWERP B,L,D

Our morning tour of Antwerp features the Cathedral of Our Lady with its three monumental altarpieces painted by Peter Paul Rubens, the Grand Square surrounded by the Golden Age Town Hall and guild halls, and Steen Castel, Antwerp's oldest building. After a free afternoon in Antwerp, we set sail for Ghent.

DAY 8 GHENT / BRUGGE B,L,D

From Ghent we travel to Brugge, one of the oldest towns in Flanders. Our guided walking tour of Brugge includes the Church of our Lady with its famous Madonna and Child by Michelangelo, the Beguinage (where women lived like nuns since 1245), and the town's scenic network of canals. We return to Ghent for lunch on board and a free afternoon in this charming, canal-filled capital of East Flanders.

DAY 9 MIDDLEBURG / DELTA WORKS B,L,D

We walk through charming Middleburg, the capital of the province of Zeeland. Then we drive to Neeltje Jans Expo to learn about how the Delta Works protect Holland from the sea. We see the hydraulic lock system and walk along the massive dam. In the afternoon we sail to Rotterdam and have a free evening there.



DAY 10 KEUKENHOF GARDENS / AMSTERDAM B,L,D

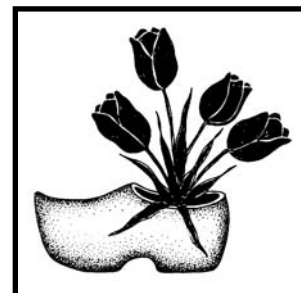
We visit the Keukenhof Gardens, the world's largest floral park. The gardens are ablaze with millions of flowering tulips, hyacinths, crocuses, and daffodils. The afternoon is free time in Amsterdam to discover more of its treasures. Just walking along the centuries-old houses flanking the canals is memorable.

DAY 11 AMSTERDAM / HOME B

We transfer to the Amsterdam airport and fly home.
