

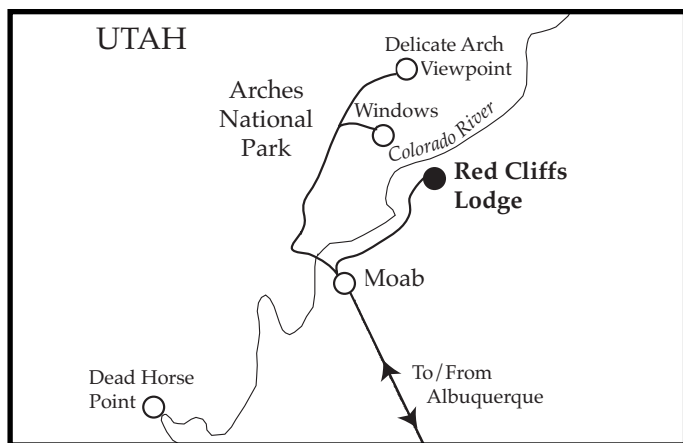
MOAB ADVENTURE at the Red Cliffs Lodge

DAY 1 ALBUQUERQUE / MOAB, UTAH

We drive across the colorful landscape of northwestern New Mexico and past the high mountains of Utah to reach Moab. We lodge four nights 16 miles upriver from Moab at the Red Cliffs Lodge.

DAY 2 ARCHES NATIONAL PARK

Arches National Park has over 100 natural stone arches. During our morning in the park we learn how nature created the arches and visit some of the finer specimens. We walk along "Park Avenue" to Courthouse Towers, see Balanced Rock and the Windows Section with Double Arch.

RED CLIFFS LODGE

DAY 3 JET BOAT ON COLORADO / "JEEP" RIDE

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We drive downstream along the Colorado to Potash Dock where we board our jet boat for an exciting (but dry) 2 hour ride. We reach the goose neck below Dead Horse Point before returning to the dock. Then we board 4-wheel-drive vehicles and take back roads up to the top of the canyon. From Dead Horse Point we look down to the river where we had cruised earlier. After exploring and shopping in downtown Moab, we return to our lodgings in mid afternoon.

DAY 4 RED CLIFFS LODGE FREE DAY

The Red Cliffs Lodge is a great place to relax and enjoy nature. The adventurous amongst us can take an optional morning rafting trip (about \$40.00 per person) on the Colorado River. Activities available at the lodge include horseback riding (additional cost), wine tasting, and hiking. Also on site is the Moab Museum of Film & Western Heritage which features "100 years of cowboy history."

DAY 5 MOAB / HOME

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We pass Utah's La Sal Mountains and Colorado's San Juan Mountains to reach New Mexico. The Shiprock, sailing in the desert, welcomes us home.
