DAY 4 HOTEL del CORONADO / WELK RESORT B,L,D

San Diego de Alcalá was the first of the great California missions founded by Father Serra. A docent shows us the mission and tells us its history. Then we visit the Hotel del Coronado, one of the world’s most famous hotels with an unmistakable silhouette. This Victorian landmark of spires and dormers is the world’s largest wood structure. After our luxurious lunch here, we have time to stroll its sandy beaches and enjoy the hotel’s ambiance, shops, and history. Then we drive to the Welk Resort Center for dinner and musical entertainment. One night’s lodging at the Welk Resort.



DAY 5 USS MIDWAY / FLY HOME

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The USS *Midway* was the longest serving carrier in U.S. Navy history and the largest ship in the world. Now the ship is docked in San Diego as a museum. We walk in the footsteps of 225,000 Midway sailors who served our country on this floating city at sea. We take a self-guided audio tour from the engine room to the captain’s bridge seeing over 60 exhibits along the way. Then we fly home to Albuquerque with happy memories of our visit to lovely San Diego.
