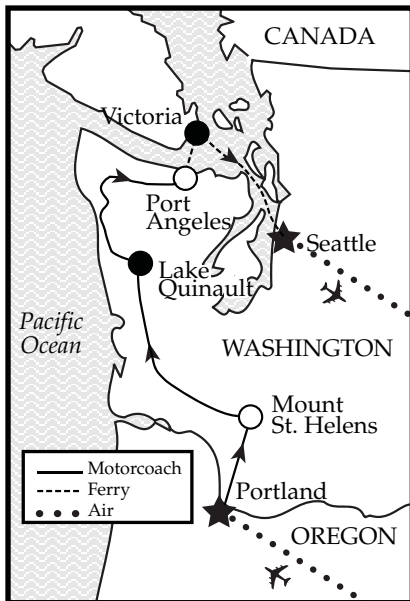

DAY 5 VICTORIA / BUTCHART GARDENS L

A guided tour introduces us to Victoria's beauty, highlights and history. After lunch in a quaint English tea room we drive to Butchart Gardens. Here flowers of every description greet us with a profusion of color in an old limestone quarry.

DAY 6 VICTORIA FREE DAY

Victoria charms each of its visitors in a different way with its British ambiance, flower baskets, tidy streets, horse-drawn tallyho carriages, night-lit Parliament buildings, salt air of the Inner Harbor and gardens everywhere. With a full day of free time we can sightsee and shop in the fascinating Inner Harbor district to our heart's content.

DAY 7 CLIPPER TO SEATTLE / SPACE NEEDLE

We ride the *Victoria Clipper* from Victoria's Inner Harbor direct to downtown Seattle. Watch for whales en route! In Seattle we ride up to the top of the Space Needle for a bird's-eye view of the city and the sea. One night's lodging in downtown Seattle.

DAY 8 SEATTLE TOUR / FLIGHT HOME

Our guided Seattle city tour features Pioneer Square, the Government Locks and Fish Ladder, Chinatown, the port, and the busy downtown. We visit 100-year-old Pike Place Market, still Seattle's heart and soul, then, transfer to the airport for our flight home.

DAY 1 FLY TO PORTLAND / CITY TOUR

We fly to Portland, Oregon, the "City of Roses." A local guide shows us the city with stops at the beautiful International Rose Test Garden and the Japanese Gardens. Two nights' lodging in downtown Portland.

DAY 2 ROSE PARADE / MANSION / FREE TIME B

We watch the Rose Festival's Grand Floral Parade from our reserved seats inside the Coliseum. The flowered floats and polished bands create a memorable spectacle. After touring the Pittock Mansion, Portland's finest historic building, we have free time to explore lovely downtown Portland.

DAY 3 MOUNT ST. HELENS / LAKE QUINAULT B,L

We cross the Columbia River from the "Beaver State" of Oregon to enter the "Evergreen State" of Washington. We drive into Mt. St. Helens National Volcanic Monument to the Johnston Ridge Observatory, the closest viewpoint to the mountain, for a panoramic view and a spectacular film. We continue to Olympic National Park where we lodge one night at historic Lake Quinault Lodge located in a sublime lakeside setting in the rain forest.

DAY 4 OLYMPIC NATIONAL PARK

We leave Lake Quinault and drive to the coast where we enjoy a cliff top view of beautiful Kalaloch Beach. We continue around the Olympic Peninsula then climb one mile of elevation to Hurricane Ridge for a stunning view of the Olympic Mountains, the Strait of Juan de Fuca and Vancouver Island (weather permitting). Then we catch a ferry across the Strait of Juan De Fuca to the Inner Harbor of Victoria, Canada. Three nights' lodging in the Inner Harbor district.
