DAY 3 PADUCAH QUILT SHOW

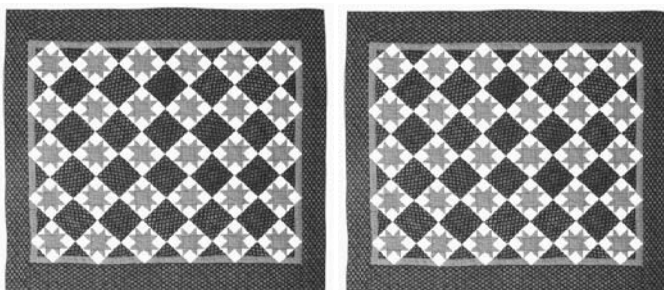
