DAY 1 FLY TO ST. LOUIS / BOTANICAL GARDEN

When we arrive in St. Louis we take a tram tour through the Missouri Botanical Garden, one of the finest in America. It features 79 acres of display gardens, indoor conservatories, and historic homes with antiques. We lodge five nights at the Drury Plaza Hotel.

DAY 2 CITY TOUR / MANSION / BREWERY B,L

Our local guide shows us St. Louis and tells us its history. The Cathedral Basilica of St. Louis is a Byzantine masterpiece. Lunch is served at the Lemp Mansion followed by a tour. Nearby is the original Anheuser-Busch Brewery where we see beer being made and sample the products.

DAY 3 ST. LOUIS ATTRACTIONS B

The Ulysses S. Grant National Historic Site includes Grant's home before the Civil War. After we learn about Grant at the historic site, we enjoy the fun activities at Grant's Farm including a wildlife farm and the Budweiser Clydesdales. We stop for a treat at Ted Drewes Frozen Custard stand, beloved by the locals. Then, in Forest Park, site of the 1904 World's Fair, we choose to visit the Missouri History Museum, the St. Louis Art Museum or the St. Louis Zoo.

DAY 4 FOX THEATER / GATEWAY ARCH B

We tour the Campbell House Museum, a carefully-restored house with original furnishings that reflects the high-Victorian opulence of the St. Louis of the 1880s. Then we tour the fabulous Fox Theater, "awe-inspiring" when it opened in 1929 and still awe-inspiring today. At the Gateway Arch, one of the most graceful and beautiful monuments in America, we see a movie showing the making of the Arch, then board tram cars to ride up to the top.

Jersey Boys at the Fox

Jersey Boys, which won the Tony Award and the Olivier Award for Best Musical, tells the story of Frankie Valli and the Four Seasons as four boys from the streets of Newark struggle to reach the top of the pop music business. It plays at the Fabulous Fox Theater, one of the most beautiful theaters in America.

DAY 5 CAHOKIA MOUNDS / JERSEY BOYS B,D

The nearby Lewis and Clark State Historic Site recreates the camp where the Expedition wintered in 1803. We cross the Mississippi again to reach historic St. Charles. We board a replica of a 19th-century steamboat for a narrated cruise on the Mississippi River. Then it's time to bid goodbye to wonderful St. Louis as we fly home.
