It works like this: Go to the Sun Tours web site at www.suntoursus.com and click the Photo Gallery link. This opens a page listing our recent tours in reverse chronological order. Find the tour that you are interested in and if it shows that photo albums have been created for the tour, just click on the tour name and the roster of photo albums will appear. Click on the album name and thumbnails of the photos appear. Then you can choose to enlarge individual photos or see a slide show of all of the photos. You can also download any photos that you like to share with your family and friends.

To upload your album is also very simple. You can post as many images as you like. You will need to call us for the password though.

BOOK EARLY

There is nothing that pains us more than when someone calls to book a cruise and we have to tell them that the ship is sold out. This had happened recently on our Canada & New England cruise. Because that cruise was so popular we are offering it again for next year (see page 36).

Booking early is always the best strategy at Sun Tours because there is usually no cancellation fee until 2-4 months prior to a cruise or tour departure. This means that if you book early you can hold the seat (and the cabin that you prefer) and still have the option to cancel (until the cancellation fees start) without being out a dime. Booking early on a Sun Tours land tour is also important because the tours often fill up.
