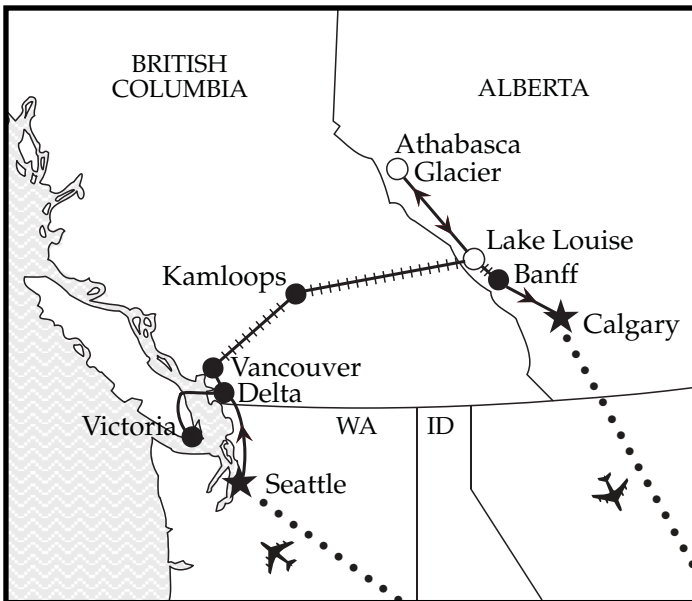

DAY 1 HOME / CANADA

We fly to Seattle and drive north across the Canadian border to lodge in Delta, British Columbia for one night.

DAY 2 BUTCHART GARDENS / VICTORIA

We board a ferry to cross the Strait of Georgia to Vancouver Island. A profusion of color greets us at Butchart Gardens where flowers of every description now grace an old limestone quarry. The rest of the afternoon is free time to shop and sightsee in the Inner Harbor district. Victoria charms each of us in a different way with its British ambiance, flower baskets, tidy streets, horse-drawn tallyho carriages, night-lit Parliament Buildings, salt air of the Inner Harbor, and gardens everywhere. The Empress Hotel and the Provincial Museums are musts. We lodge two nights in Victoria.

DAY 3 VICTORIA TOUR & FREE TIME

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A guided tour introduces us to Victoria's beauty, highlights, and history. We enjoy a whole afternoon of free time visiting great attractions and soaking in the delightful ambiance.

DAY 4 VANCOUVER CITY TOUR

We return to the mainland by ferry and continue to Vancouver, a gorgeous city with mountains in the background and the sea in the foreground. With our local guide we see and learn about Vancouver's vigorous downtown, Stanley Park, Gastown, Queen Elizabeth Park's Sunken Gardens, Chinatown, and more. We lodge one night in downtown Vancouver.

DAY 5 "ROCKY MOUNTAINEER"

All 'board for "The Most Spectacular Train Trip in the World." Our two-day train ride on the "Rocky Mountaineer" features reclining deluxe seats and picture windows. Today we criss-cross the Fraser River as it winds through its steep-walled canyon, then follow the Thompson River into the scenic interior of British Columbia. We lodge one night at a Kamloops hotel while our train lodges at the station.

DAY 6 "ROCKY MOUNTAINEER" B, L

We reboard our waiting train for the most spectacular portion of our journey. After passing through the lovely Lake District, we climb the mountains of Canada's Glacier National Park to Rogers Pass. Then we drop down to the upper Columbia River valley before climbing even higher mountains. We ride through the "Spiral Tunnels," to surmount Kicking Horse Pass on the Continental Divide. We ride down the scenic Bow River valley to Banff where we lodge three nights in the heart of the Canadian Rockies in Banff National Park.

DAY 7 BANFF / LAKE LOUISE L

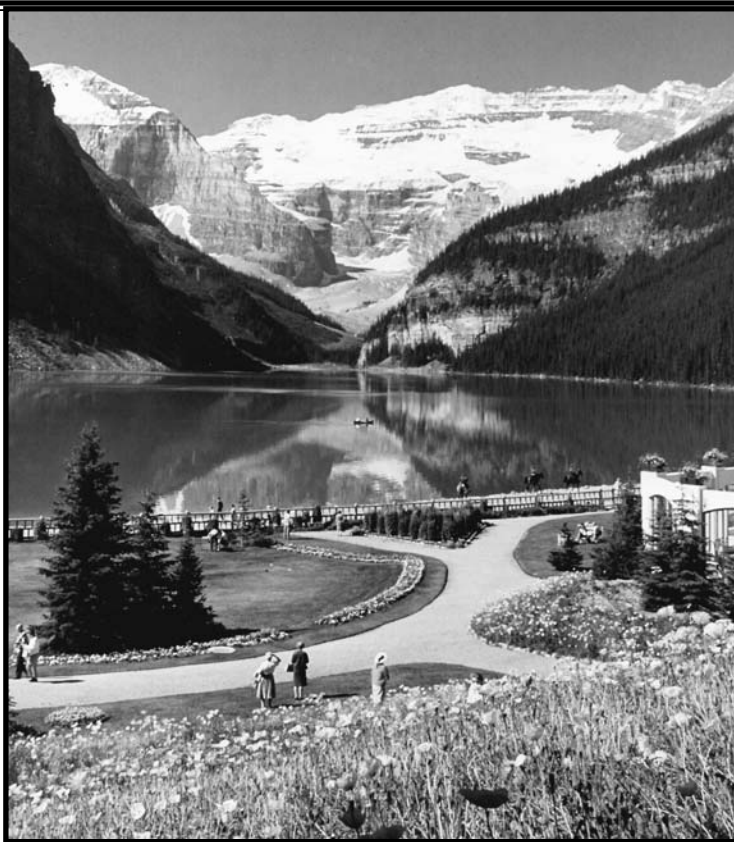
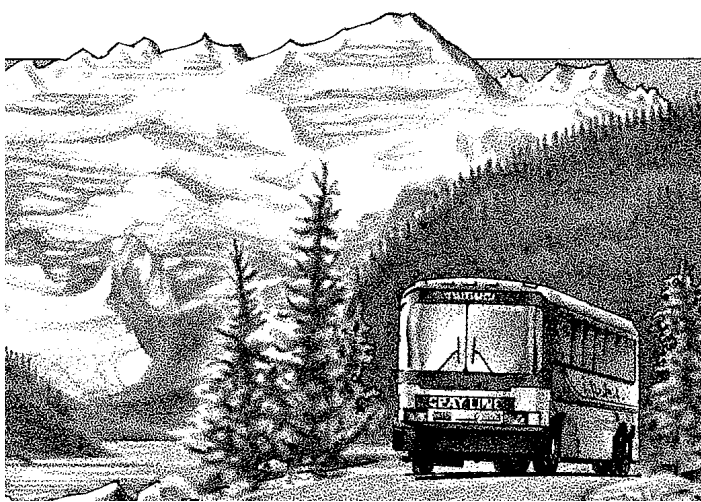
In the morning we ride the gondola cars up Banff's Sulphur Mountain for lofty views of the Bow River cutting between Mt. Rundel and Cascade Mountain. Then we drive up the Bow Valley to Moraine Lake, a gorgeous turquoise lake called the "jewel of the Rockies." At the Chateau Lake Louise we marvel at the world-renowned view of Lake Louise and Victoria Glacier. We have time to visit the Chateau's fancy shops and walk along the lakeshore.

DAY 8 ICEFIELD PARKWAY / GLACIER

Our excursion is along the Icefields Parkway, the most scenic route in the Canadian Rockies. Jagged snow-capped mountains line both sides of the narrow valley. Wildlife is often seen along the way. At the Columbia Icefield we board a giant snowcoach for a ride onto the Athabasca Glacier. We return to Banff viewing the spectacular scenery from a new perspective.

DAY 9 BANFF / HOME

We descend out of the mountains and return to the Calgary airport for our flight home. The beauty of the Rockies has now been turned into indelible memories.
