DAY 1 HOME / LOS ANGELES / LONG BEACH

We fly to Los Angeles and drive to Long Beach where we visit the Rancho los Alamitos. Here the story of Southern California unfolds as we tour the adobe ranch house, built around 1800, and explore four acres of historic gardens. We lodge two nights in Long Beach.

DAY 2 CATALINA ISLAND B

We board a fast ferry for the 22-mile crossing to Avalon on Catalina Island. We walk from the pier to the heart of Avalon where cars are banned. This romantic resort town has excitement in the air and lots of fun things to do. We have free time to soak in the beauty, enjoy the ambiance, shop and explore this afternoon before we sail back to Long Beach.

DAY 3 REAGAN LIBRARY / AUTRY MUSEUM B

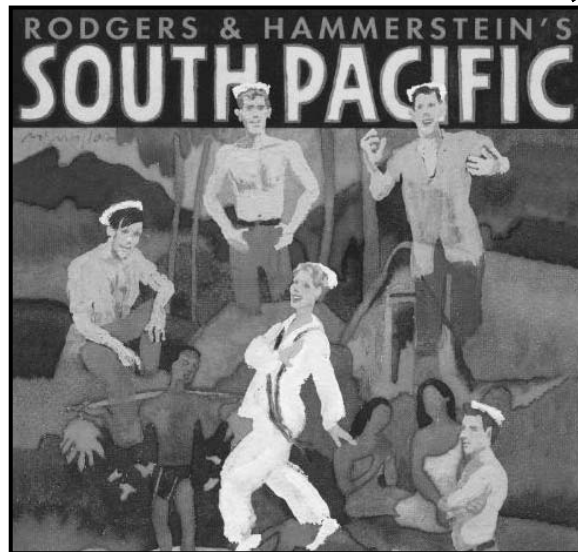
We drive from Long Beach to Simi Valley and the Reagan Presidential Library. This impressive facility, situated on a hilltop overlooking the Pacific Ocean, houses both the memorabilia of President Reagan's life and his Air Force One. The Autry Museum of the American West presents the history of the American West and its depiction by Hollywood. We view Billy the Kid's gun, Wyatt Earp's badge, 40,000 other artifacts, original costumes and props. We lodge two nights in Los Angeles.

DAY 4 LA CITY TOUR / SOUTH PACIFIC B,D
