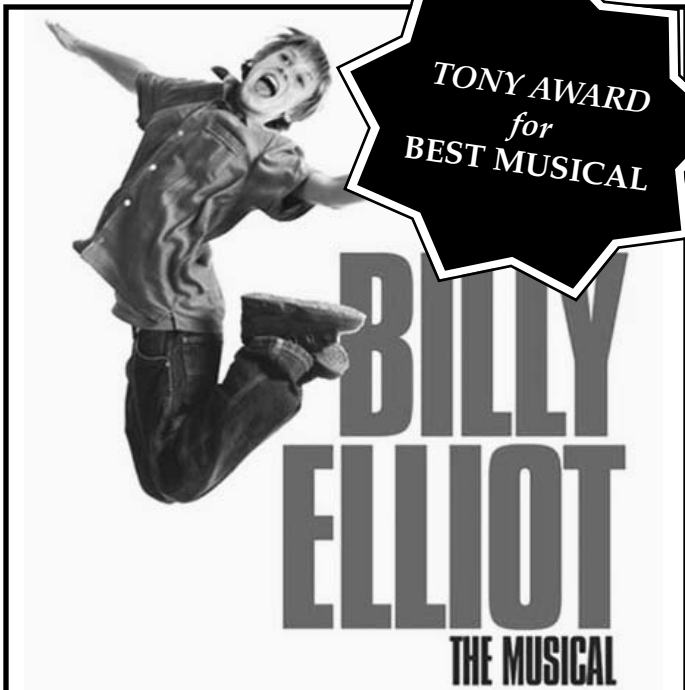

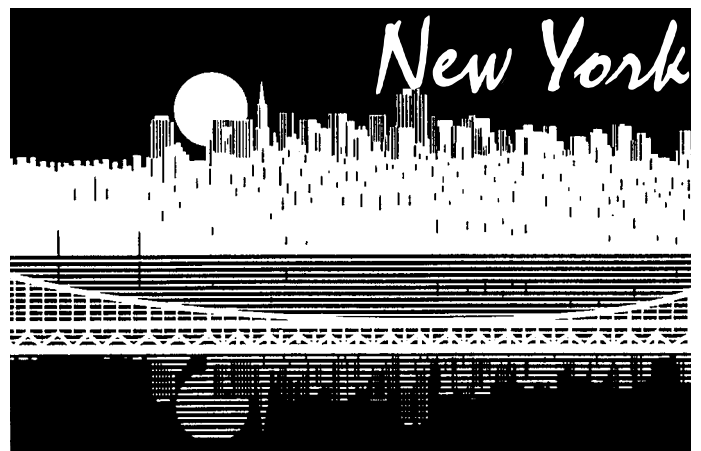
The Millennium Broadway is one of the top hotels near Times Square. It is in the heart of the Broadway Theater District.

DAY 2 NEW YORK CITY TOUR

A local guide joins us for a half-day tour of Midtown and lower Manhattan. There is so much to see: Times Square, Herald Square, Macy's, the Garment District, Soho, Washington Square, Greenwich Village, Chinatown, City Hall, the Brooklyn Bridge, and much more. In the Financial District our guide leads a walking tour past Wall Street, the Stock Exchange, Federal Hall, the Federal Reserve Building, Trinity Church, and Ground Zero, once the site of the World Trade Center. We then tour the United Nations Headquarters building and learn about its history, see gifts from around the world, and enter the impressive General Assembly Hall.

DAY 3 FREE DAY / BILLY ELLIOT

DAY 4 **STATUE OF LIBERTY / ELLIS ISLAND**

Today we drive to the lower tip of Manhattan to catch a ferry to the Statue of Liberty on Liberty Island. This international symbol of freedom is also the tallest statue in the world. Another ferry takes us to nearby Ellis Island, the point of entry for millions of immigrants from 1892 to 1924. The museum chronicles its history and the immigrants themselves. We ferry back to Manhattan and reach our hotel late in the afternoon. New York is at your service tonight with a splendid array of evening entertainment options.

DAY 5 **FREE DAY / THEATER**

Having a free day in Manhattan is like being a kid in a candy store. There is so much to do and to explore. **THEATER TONIGHT!** We attend one of Broadway's top shows.

DAY 6 **NEW YORK CITY TOUR**

With our guide on board we drive past the Cathedral of St. John the Divine, Columbia University, Riverside Church, and Grant's Tomb plus a drive through Harlem. We return to midtown via Central Park and Fifth Avenue. Watch for the museums, elegant shops, and mansions. We take the Stage Door Tour of the Radio City Music Hall where we explore the beautiful art-deco interiors, learn the secrets of the Great Stage, and meet a Rockette! Then our guide leads us through Rockefeller Center and nearby St. Patrick's Cathedral. We end our day on the "Top of the Rock," with unparalleled views from the Observation Deck on the 70th floor of 30 Rockefeller Center.
