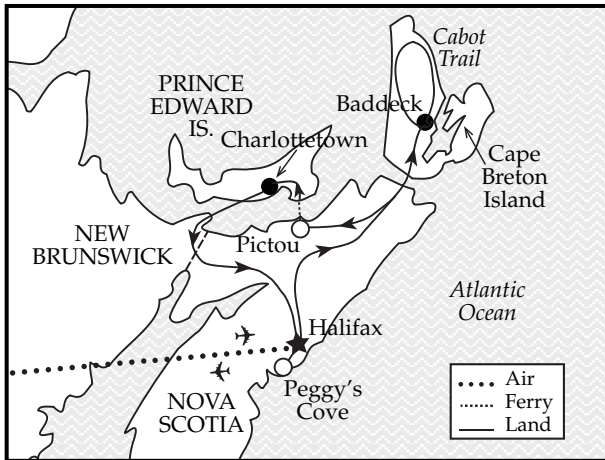

DAY 1 FLY TO HALIFAX

Today we fly to Halifax, Nova Scotia, to lodge two nights.

DAY 2 HALIFAX / PEGGY'S COVE

Our morning tour of Halifax includes Government House, Province House, St. Paul's Church, and the harbor area. The view of Halifax is stunning from the heights of the Citadel. We drive to Peggy's Cove, a rustic fishing village built around a snug harbor. With glacier-polished granite rocks, a quaint harbor, and a picturesque lighthouse on Rocky Point, Peggy's Cove is the delight of artists and photographers.

DAY 3 NOVA SCOTIA / CAPE BRETON ISLAND D

We drive north through the scenic Nova Scotia countryside, then cross the Canso Strait to Cape Breton Island. In Baddeck we visit the Alexander Graham Bell Museum. The museum showcases the many scientific achievements and personal mementos of the man who invented the telephone and lived here for 35 years. We lodge two nights in Baddeck.

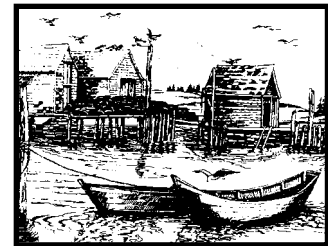
DAY 4 CABOT TRAIL / CAPE BRETON PARK B,L,D

A local guide joins us for our full-day excursion along the Cabot Trail through Acadian villages and Cape Breton Highlands National Park. The scenery is Nova Scotia's finest, with a striking resemblance to coastal Scotland: steep mountains along the western shore, stream-lined villages, heath bogs with stunted trees and rocky coves on the eastern shore. Keep a watch out for moose and bald eagles!

DAY 5 BADDECK / CHARLOTTETOWN B

We leave Cape Breton Island as we cross the Canso Strait. Then a ferry takes us across the 14-mile Northumberland Strait to Prince Edward Island. Tonight we attend the musical, "Anne of Green Gables," at the Confederation Centre of the Arts. We lodge two nights in Charlottetown.

DAY 6 PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND D

We visit Province House, where Canada's confederation was organized, then enjoy free time in charming downtown Charlottetown. On our guided afternoon tour of Prince Edward Island, each bend in the road reveals a new and delightful combination of red soil farm fields, rivers, dairy cows, sheep, venerable farm houses, flowers, and trees. We visit Anne of Green Gables House and Prince Edward Island National Park. Lobster dinner tonight!

DAY 7 PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND / HALIFAX

We take our leave of Anne's Prince Edward Island via the nine-mile-long Confederation Bridge. Back on the mainland we drive across Nova Scotia back to Halifax where we lodge one night. We have lots of free time to enjoy the historic waterfront area near our hotel which has so many great attractions and shopping options.

Today we leave Canada and return home with wonderful memories of our maritime adventure.
