**DAY 2 CITY TOUR / FREE TIME**

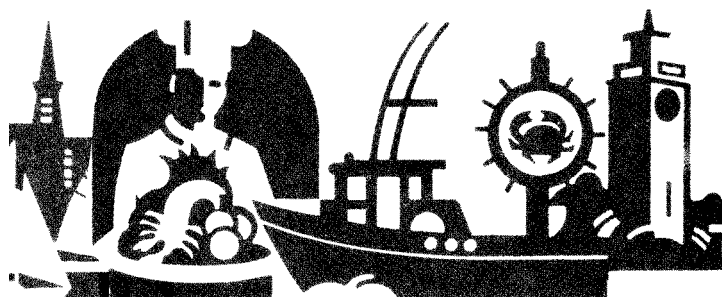
