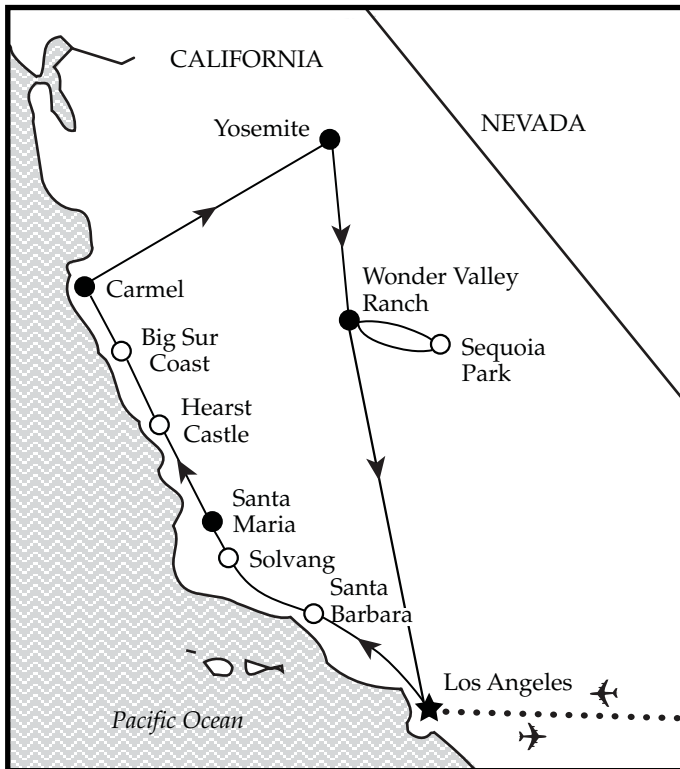


HEART OF CALIFORNIA

 Central California has some of the world's greatest attractions, but the heart of this tour is our visit to Wonder Valley Ranch. The friendly staff of the ranch will create a fun-filled and memorable visit.



DAY 1 FLY TO LAX / REAGAN LIBRARY

We fly to Los Angeles and drive to Simi Valley, site of the Ronald Reagan Presidential Library. Here we see artifacts from President Reagan's childhood, acting career, and political career. We also walk through Air Force One and see his grave site overlooking the Pacific Ocean. We lodge one night in Thousand Oaks.

DAY 2 SANTA BARBARA / SOLVANG

We drive past fertile fields along a scenic route to Santa Barbara where we visit Santa Barbara Mission, one of the best preserved of California's missions. Our tour of Santa Barbara includes the city's vital downtown and the Spanish-Moorish-style County Courthouse. We continue to Solvang which is Danish in its heritage, atmosphere, and architecture. We lodge one night in Santa Maria.

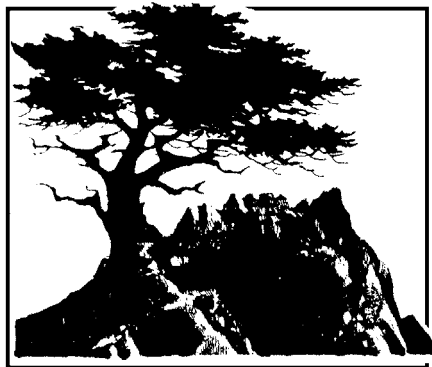
Wonder Valley Ranch

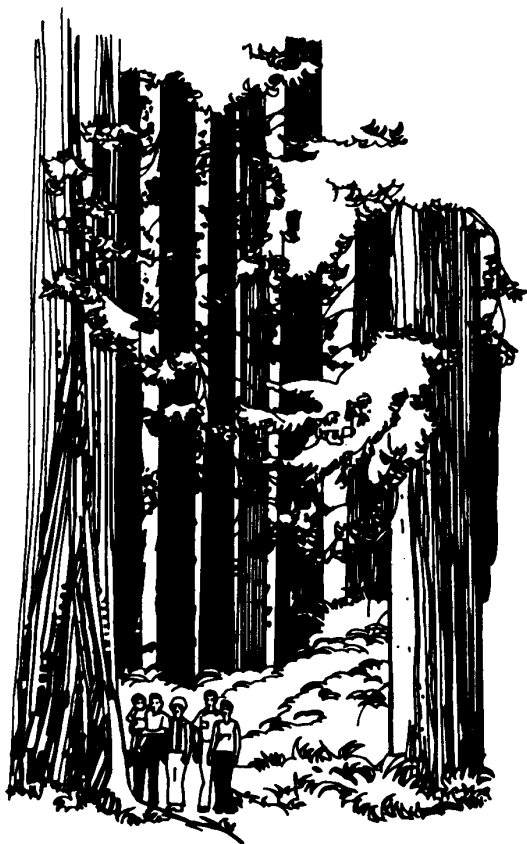
DAY 3 HEARST CASTLE / BIG SUR B

At San Simeon we tour the estate of William Randolph Hearst who built the Hearst Castle at a cost of over 50 million dollars. Then we follow the spectacular Big Sur coastline along Highway 1 suspended halfway between heaven and the Pacific Ocean. We reach Carmel to lodge two nights.

DAY 4 CARMEL / MONTEREY / 17-MILE DR. B

The Monterey Peninsula is one of California's most beautiful areas. The lavender-colored ice plant, the characteristic Monterey cypress trees, and the playful sea otter give the area a unique character. In Monterey we visit the Monterey Bay Aquarium and Cannery Row which was made famous in the John Steinbeck novel. Then we follow Pebble Beach's 17-Mile Drive as it threads between golf courses and the rocky coast where sea lions share their rocks with cormorants. Later this afternoon we enjoy free time in lovely downtown Carmel.

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DAY 5 YOSEMITE NATIONAL PARK B,L

We cross California's San Joaquin Valley, where much of America's fruits, vegetables and nuts are grown, to reach Yosemite National Park. Yosemite Valley has some of America's most beautiful scenery: Yosemite Falls, Bridal Veil Falls, and the sheer granite walls of El Capitan and Half Dome. We view the scenery from different perspectives, then lodge in Yosemite for one night.

DAY 6 YOSEMITE / WONDER VALLEY RANCH D

We see Yosemite's beauty one more time as we leave the valley behind. If the snow has receded we ride a tram into the Mariposa Grove of giant Sequoia trees. If not, we visit the Pioneer Yosemite History Center. Then we continue on to Wonder Valley Ranch, California's first guest ranch, located east of Fresno. The friendly and solicitous staff creates an environment that is fun for all. Tonight we enjoy a hayride, a cowboy singer, and buffet dinner.

DAY 7 SEQUOIA / KINGS CANYON B,L,D

With a Wonder Valley Ranch guide we drive into the foothills of the Sierra Nevada Mountains to reach Sequoia and Kings Canyon National Parks. These parks feature the world's greatest concentration of giant sequoia trees, the largest of all living things. We see Grant Grove featuring the General Grant Tree and the Giant Forest with the General Sherman Tree, the largest sequoia on earth. We return to Wonder Valley Ranch for dinner and "Table Top Television Review," a game show with audience participation about the golden age of television.

DAY 8 WONDER VALLEY / HOME B

We say "good-bye" to our Wonder Valley Ranch "family." The drive back to the Los Angeles airport passes farmland, desert and National Forest land. Then we fly home with warm memories of Wonder Valley Ranch and the Heart of California.
